

CWA is introducing our 'Camp Moms Program'. The 'Camp Mom Program' gives mothers the opportunity to attend the camp for free, get a hunter safety certificate and participate with the campers in many of the camp activities. There will be a limited number of spots available for 'Camp Moms' at each camp. CWA Camp Mom Requirements and Responsibilities

1. You will be required to fill out the CWA background check form and get fingerprinted along with all other overnight chaperones prior to the camp. The background check and fingerprinting process will take 2-3 weeks and will be paid for by CWA.
2. Overnight accommodations will be provided along with the young lady campers. The accommodations available vary by camp so discuss details with the camp coordinator.
3. You will be asked to help with some of the camp chores and as group leader during camp activities.

Special activities for Camp Mom's

1. You will get to participate free of charge in hunter education and gun safety instruction including shooting range time with the campers. You will be able to take the hunter safety test required for a California hunting license with the campers at the conclusion of the camp.
2. Camp Mom's are also eligible to participate in:
 - duck banding
 - egg salvage
 - wood duck box management
 - shooting
 - waterfowl hunting workshops

Each camp itinerary varies depending on location so specific details should be discussed with the camp coordinator.
